
### Stockton United Methodist Church portico on east side of building

---

#### Recycle these bulbs for free:

- compact fluorescents (CFLs)
- incandescent
- halogen
- Christmas lights



#### Recycle these mercury-containing bulbs for a fee

that passes directly to the companies that extract mercury, a complicated procedure for processing hazardous materials.

- light emitting diode bulbs (LEDs)--\$1.50/unit
- florescent and LED tubes (1-ft-4-ft)—\$1/unit
- florescent and LED tubes (5-ft-8-ft)—\$2/unit
- U-tubes \$2/unit
- projector--\$8/unit
- Shattershield/High Intensity Discharge (including metal halide)—\$3/unit
- Shattershield (1-ft-4-ft)—\$3/unit
- Shattershield (5-ft-8-ft)—\$4/unit

**CASH ONLY, PLEASE. WE DO NOT ACCEPT BROKEN BULBS.**

**To safely transport** CFL and metal halide bulbs, seal each one in a Zip-lock bag, one per bag.

To prevent accidental breakage, transport florescent and LED tubes in the box the new ones came in (you can take your box back home) or carefully and securely wrap them in newspaper taped across the ends or other protective material to prevent them from sliding out.

For safely, we cannot store bulbs in the church at any other time so please drop them off only Sunday, February 8, 9:15-9:40 a.m. or the following Wednesday, February 11, 9:30-11:30 a.m.

SUMC is located east of the square on Hwy. MO-32 at the intersection of Hwy. J. Follow signs and arrows to the SUMC east portico where a Go Green Team volunteer will safely collect your bulbs from your trunk or back seat. Please stay in your car and do not unload them yourself.
